## Linking Assignment to Discussion Board

This tutorial will demonstrate how to create a link to connect your assignment section to the Discussion Board. You can use this example to include forums from your Blackboard in each module.

1. Once inside your course, make sure Edit Mode (upper right corner) has been turned 'On'.



2. From your course menu on the left choose where you want to display the *Discussion Board* Link



3. From the 'Add Interactive tool' dropdown, choose 'Discussion Board'

- 4. The next window will give you three options:
  - a. The first one gives you a link to the <u>all Forums</u> that you have on your *Discussion Board*;
  - b. the second one gives you the option <u>specify the Forum</u> that you would like the student to respond to;
  - c. in case you do not have the forum created yet, the third option allows you to <u>create the</u> <u>forum</u> that you would like the student to respond to.
