- 4. Student projects must be of value and significance, presented to the public, and subject to external evaluation. External evaluation is defined as a project that is disseminated by one of the following methods: publication in a refereed journal, invited publication in a journal/book or pedagogical materials, presentation at refereed or invited conferences at the national/regional or state levels.
- 5. Faculty nominated for this award will be contacted and are responsible for providing all necessary materials to document that they meet the criteria. Persons nominating faculty must attach a letter of recommendation to this form.
